GENERAL RULES:

1. Exhibitor must be either a resident of Milam Co. or attend school in Milam Co. and must meet the following requirements:
 - a. Must be enrolled in a public or private elementary or secondary school.
 - b. Must be a minimum of five years old and in kindergarten as of September 1st of the current school year.
 - c. Must be a member of a Milam Co. 4-H or a Milam Co. FFA Chapter.
2. All applications for entry must be made on the proper entry card. This card must be filled out and signed by parent or guardian. Entry fees must accompany all entries. On peewee entries (5-8 years old) parents must sign for the extension agent. Entries WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED without proper signatures.

Entry cards and fees must be turned into SHOW SECRETARY on show registration night. Dates will Be: Thorndale – Tuesday, February 7, location to be announced. Cameron – Thursday, February 9, Youth Expo Building. Contact your C.E.A, or Ag Science Teacher for further information. All entries must be received by secretary no later than February 9, 2023. After February 9, late entries will be accepted until March 22th for an ADDITIONAL \$100.00 per entry.

3. An exhibitor ineligible, according to his/her school administration, will **not** be permitted to show, or have an entry shown.
4. The Milam Co. Jr. Livestock Show Assn. will in no way be responsible for any loss, injury, or damage to the exhibitor or to his or her exhibits, or injury to any individual that may occur during the duration of the show.
5. Each exhibitor may have three (3) entries in the Baked Food Show. Only one (1) entry per category.
6. The following are categories to exhibit in the Baked Food Show:
 - A. CAKE: Decorations and garnishes are acceptable BUT MUST BE EDIBLE.
 - B. PIE: Fruit or nut – pie crust must be made from scratch.
 - C. COOKIES: drop, rolled, or shaped: A recipe amount (2 dozen or more).

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to determine the proper entry category. An item entered in the wrong category or that does not meet all the entry standards as stated above may be subject to point deduction and will be changed to the proper category.

7. Showmanship will be divided into 3 divisions based on ages the day of the show.

Peewee Kindergarten thru 2nd grade.
Juniors 13 Years and Under
Seniors 14 Years and Older

FOOD ENTRY PREPARATION RULES

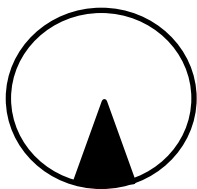
1. ENTRIES MUST BE BAKED OR COOKED. Entries must be made by exhibitor. All entries must be made from scratch and no ready-mix foods may be used.
2. It is illegal for minors to be in possession of alcohol; therefore, recipes which call for alcohol are prohibited.
3. No refrigerated or cold items. Any item needing refrigeration will be disqualified. This includes, but not limited to meringue, ice box, and cheesecakes. NO CREAM CHEESE. If you have questions please verify with the superintendent.
4. Entries must be displayed in containers available through the Baked Food Committee.

Entries must be visible from outside the container for judges' viewing. If recipe states item must remain in the pan, disposable foil pan is allowed, displayed in a container as described above.

Containers may be picked up Monday, March 13, 2023, 6:00 – 7:00 p.m. at the YEB.

5. A sample from each entry, two cookies or one piece of cake must be cut or taken from the entry for judging. **DO NOT CUT PIES.** Place the cake sample on a small white disposable plate and wrap with plastic wrap. Cookies should be on a small white disposable plate inside a plastic zip bag. Place on top of the container so judges can sample without disturbing the cover of the container. The cut side of the entry must be placed to the front of the container for the judges' viewing. **DO NOT CUT PIES.**

RECIPE:

1. The recipe must include a complete list of ingredients, mixing and baking instructions (including pie crust, frosting, glaze, etc.), size of pan used, temperature, cooking time, how much the recipe makes, and any edible garnishes/decorations.
2. The recipe should be typed or printed on a half or full sheet of paper. If additional space is needed, attach additional pages. Do NOT print on back.
3. **MUST HAVE 2 COPIES OF THE RECIPE:**
Tape one recipe to the outside back of the container, print facing out.
Have 1 copy available to present to the showmanship judge.
4. Do **NOT** include any personal information (name, city, club/chapter) on recipe.
5. Recipes may be published at a later date.
6. Grand Champion may **NOT** enter **that** recipe again.

JUDGING, PREMIUM PAYOUT, AND SILENT AUCTION:

1. Grand Champion winner will be selected from the 1st place winners of the 3 categories (Cake, Pie, and Cookies).
2. Premiums will be paid according to the number of entries.
3. After judging is complete, a placing list will be posted and entries will be available for public viewing.
4. During public viewing, entries may be sold on behalf of the exhibitor. Minimum bid will be \$50.00. There are no restrictions on maximum donation amount.
